- CAD/PAD Issues
  - Vendor technical challenges; production/quality/capacity/DMSMS
- > Approach to address challenges
  - ❖ Increased "Safety Level" of stockpile from 9 to 18 months
  - Increased strategic contracting initiatives: IDIQs & Multiple Award Contracts
  - Actively pursuing Second Sources for multiple NSNs
  - Robust Aging & Surveillance test program
  - Implement energetic material management & recertification plans
  - Prioritizing Joint Product Improvement Program to redesign/requalify obsolete parts
  - ❖ DoD Joint Program obsolescence team to forecast potential program risks
    - JPO R&D resources evaluating 3-D printing and other technological solutions



#### Issue:

Late contract awards with Navy Purchase Request

#### Cause:

- Cobham no bid solicitations, Stratus' first submittal of cost data delayed contract award
- Stratus has production backlog w/3 years USN, USAF & FMS requirements
- 2 x LAT Failure: Rebuild Completed

#### Impact:

- Hazard Risk Analysis was conducted to determine risk associated with continued use of Stratus specific FLU-9B/P Inflators beyond their currently assigned shelf/service life
- Components being used beyond shelf life/service life requirements. Temporary life extensions supportable up to 24 months beyond original expiration.
- Maintenance time change interval requirements cannot be supported.

  - 01-0-01-200-0AA increase from 72/72 to 96/96

### Canopy Remover Cartridge

ZAMAMENT DIRECTURES

#### Issue:

- USAF and FMS partner countries have urgent and compelling requirements for Canopy Remover Cartridges
- Note: There are currently 58 USAF and 89 FMS extensions.

#### Cause:

- Historically Indian Head & BAE struggled to produce useable quantities of HES 5808.32 propellant
  - HES 5808 propellant was optimized to increase producibility & reduce variability (~2019)
  - Energetic output shifted continuing to make HES 5808.32 propellant difficult to use
- Contract Required Deliveries:
  - Multiple contracts late to need from FY18-FY23
    - Late award of contracts
    - Manufacturing difficulties resulting in delays
    - Performance issues during pre-build testing
    - Late acquisition/delivery of hardware from sub-tier suppliers

#### Impact:

- Warfighters flying on temporary life extensions beyond original expiration
  - ❖ SPO Operational Risk Assessment (Medium Risk), dated 21 April 2022

#### Get Well:

- ❖ Technical efforts to resolve propellant issues have identified HES 5808.29 as alternate propellant
  - HES 5808.29 has shown good test results
  - ❖ Preliminary production activities in work to incorporate HES 5808.29 propellant
